The decision was 8-1. The Supreme Court said that the church is is entitled to special protection under the first ammendment and that protection cannot be overcome by a jury finding that their picketing was outrageous.

The Westboro Church members protest outside military funerals with anti-gay messages, believing that deaths in Afghanistan and Iraq are punishment by God for tolerence of gays in the United States.
